

OPENING YOUR OFCU ACCOUNT



DOCUMENTS

There are specific documents you will need in order to open your first account with OFCU.

- **Two (2) forms of ID**

- 1. Government issued photo ID such as a drivers license, state ID, military ID or passport
- 2. Social Security card, birth certificate, paystub, hunting license, vehicle registration, health insurance card or a second item from the photo ID options above
- Under 18? Still need two (2) forms of ID - typically birth certificate and social security card.
 - With a government issued photo ID, your account can be opened without a parent/guardian.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are not using your Social Security card as a form of identification, you will still need to know & provide your Social Security number to open an account

- **Proof of Address**

- Current physical address needs to be on at least one form of ID that is provided
 - A deed/lease agreement or utility bill such as CMP or cable can also serve as proof of address

Be prepared to provide some additional information.

- **What kind of account(s) would you like to open?**

- To become an OFCU member, you will need to open a Share Savings account with a \$5 deposit
- Checking (Draft) accounts come with a debit card

- **Who would you like to be your beneficiary?**

- This is the person you choose to inherit your accounts

- **What is your current contact information?**

- Phone number(s) and/or email address
